

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## SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

- 1. The school is managed by the Catholic Church and all pupils are required to attend Mass and any other spiritual related function organized by the church.
- 2. The school does not change any pupil's faith but it helps them to acquire good morals and values which will help them to be good people in the society.
- 3. Laziness will not be accepted. Pupils should work hard to achieve their goals.
- 4. All pupils are expected to keep their hair short or plait plain lines. No dreads, beads or hair extension or hijab will be allowed.
- 5. Habitual indiscipline or misbehavior will lead to suspension first, followed by dismissal.
- 6. Any communication concerning pupils should strictly be done through the office.
- 7. No parent is allowed to go beyond the manager's office or see any teaching/subordinate staff members without permission.
- 8. The pupils are expected to communicate in English all the time.
- 9. Any communication concerning the school affairs to outside authorities should be through the manager's office.
- 10. Pupils are not allowed to communicate with outsiders through the fence or even parents without permission.
- 11. No food is allowed in the dorms for boarders. During visiting days, parents should bring what is enough for the child to finish.
- 12. Every pupil is encouraged and expected to use his/her common sense in whatever one does.
- 13. Pupils are expected to avoid noise in the school and be calm all the time.
- 14. Pupils should report to school from 8.00am to 4.00 pm during opening days. Any lateness should be reported to the schools administration.
- 15. All pupils should report to the office after arrival. If any pupil is found in the school compound without any report the administration will be forced to send that pupil home.
- 16. A clear medical report should be provided in the school in case of any acute problems/allergies.



- 17. All the school fees and any outstanding balances for medical/travel etc. shall be paid on or before the term starts.
- 18. Fees should be paid in two installments i.e. during opening 75% and after mid break. If fees payment is not cleared by that time, no pupil will be allowed into the hostel or classrooms until fees are cleared.
- 19. Fees should be paid only on weekdays to the school's clerk and a receipt issued for the fees paid. If any parent sends anybody to pay fees and the amount disappears the administration will not be liable for it.
- 20. Fees should be paid in money order, banker's cheque, through pay bill or deposit in the schools account. NO CASH, PERSONAL/COMPANY cheques will be accepted. Please get account numbers of the school from the secretary.
- 21. No visitors are allowed to visit the class rooms, staffroom or the hostels without permission.
- 22. All pupils are required to be regular and punctual in attendance to lessons, meals and to any other school activity. Preps must be attended to promptly and after lights are off all should maintain silence in their dorms.
- 23. A high standard of cleanliness should be maintained at the hostels and the entire school.
- 24. All the pupils are expected to be in full school uniform while in school or school related activities and tours. No home clothes are allowed in the school.
- 25. All P.E. lessons and games are to be attended by all pupils who must change the prescribed P.E kits.
- 26. Any pupil who carelessly or maliciously damages any school property or fellow pupil's property will be punished and the parent/guardian compelled to replace.
- 27. All pupils must respect both teaching and non-teaching staff. The prefects and class monitors represent the administration and should be given due to respect.
- 28. All school assignments should be completed in time and handed in for marking.
- 29. Incase of advertisement of the school your child photo maybe used.
